FAST-TRACK PROFESSIONAL DIPLOMA FOR SENIOR PERMACULTURISTS

PINA's Board of Directors has invited about 60 Senior Permaculturists — generally those with ten to twenty years of experience in the field — to apply for its Professional Diploma on the basis of work already accomplished. For invitees whom PINA's Board of Directors believes meet our criteria, PINA is abbreviating its diploma process while still ensuring professional standards.

PINA'S WORKING DEFINITION FOR SENIOR PERMACULTURISTS

Senior permaculturists embody a passion for permaculture, having devoted much of their professional lives to developing and promoting a vision far ahead of its time, yet crucially important for the present. Through diverse pursuits, senior permaculturists have disseminated the permaculture concept throughout North America, have exemplified permaculture ethics and integrity, and have made unique contributions to the field.

In addition to meeting those general criteria, senior permaculturists who qualify for a fast-track diploma also fulfill specific requirements for each permaculture discipline:

FAST-TRACK DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR DESIGNERS

• Have at least 10 years of practical in-depth experience in design work, completing at least 20 permaculture designs in a diversity of contexts, at a variety of scales.

FAST-TRACK DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR TEACHERS

- Have maintained the ethics and integrity of the Mollison curriculum.
- Have taught permaculture for over 10 years, leading a minimum of 20 courses: PDCs, Advanced Design Courses, or Teacher Training Courses.
- Have at least 10 years of practical in-depth experience in design work, completing at least 10 permaculture designs at a variety of scales.

PINA seeks to acknowledge and honor these achievements with its professional credential. Membership in PINA is required to apply. The diploma application fee is \$200.
