- Pop-up nurseries are low-cost, seasonal, and effective entry models.

- Tours and demonstrations are powerful marketing tools.
- Culinary partnerships with chefs open niche markets.
- Fertilization recipes (minerals + compost) set trees up for long-term success.
- Apprenticeships ensure nursery skills are passed to the next generation.
