■ Permaculture Nursery Quick Cheat Sheet (Peter Janes)

- Many nurseries start by accident grow what you love, sell the surplus.
- Customers want diversity & rare plants offer what big-box stores don't.
- A greenhouse is essential start seeds and cuttings under protection.
- Adapt to local climate design for rainfall, drought, and soils.
- Use seed-grown rootstocks deeper taproots = drought tolerance.
- Handle seeds fresh refrigerate in damp medium, don't dry if avoidable.
- Learn from neighbors & elders local knowledge is priceless.
- Use cuttings for quick crops grapes, figs, elderberries, hardy kiwis.
- Graft for resilience & predictability pair local rootstocks with market scions.
- Study continuously invest in a propagation reference book.
